Session With UNICEF (Zoom)



A question and answer session was moderated by Dr. Humaira Irshad, Health Officer of UNICEF.


Workshop at Bunyad Foundation, Lahore

Talk by Mr. Debashis Paul on his book: "I Have Autism and I Like to Play Bad Tennis".




An inspiring and heart-touching webinar was held on 19th August,2023 hosted by ASDWT Lahore. Mr. Debashis Paul is a professional management & marketing consultant in India. He is father of an autistic young man and a motivational speaker on awareness and understanding of autism. Mr. Debashis Paul talked about the journey of his son Noel. He said that the book is an attempt to alter the general view of autism, and most importantly, it serves as a handy guide for parents of neuro-diverse as well as neuro-typical children. It also emphasizes acceptance, respect and inclusion of persons with autism. Ms. Rukhsana Shah, CEO ASDWT, moderated the session and discussion.

Training Sessions with Punjab Vocational Training Council (PVTC)

ASDWT Lahore organized two training sessions for Punjab Vocational Training Council (PVTC) on 8th and 14th September 2023. PVTC is the largest vocational training provider in the country having centres in all districts of the Punjab. The Zoom sessions were attended by more than 400 PVTC Principals and Teachers from all over the province. The first session was conducted by Ms. Ayesha Arooj on Mental Health and Stress Management. The second session was conducted by Ms. Rukhsana Shah on Training and Employment of adults with Autism and I/DD. She emphasized that it is not difficult to extend training opportunities to these individuals, as long as trainers are aware of their unique characteristics and needs, and create structured transition plans, curriculum modifications and essential support strategies for their vocational trainings and job readiness. The sessions were followed by interactive Q&A session.





Government Training College for Teachers of Deaf (GTCTD), Gung Mahal, Lahore

Ms. Farah Amanat conducted an Awareness Session on Understanding Autism for teachers of Gung Mahal where she discussed the core features of autism, behavior and sensory issues faced by children with this disorder. She explained that students with speech issues and hearing problems could also have features of autism and related neurodevelopmental disorders and must be diagnosed properly for effective speech therapy and other interventions. Team ASDWT also visited the resource room of GTCTD and suggested areas for improvement and future collaboration.

ACELP Awareness Session

ASDWT Karachi was invited by The Association for Children with Emotional and Learning Problems (ACELP) for an Awareness Session on ADHD for their teachers and therapists. Signs, symptoms and causes was covered by Dr. Salma Khalil while Treatment & Management of ADHD was addressed by Ms. Rao Umara. Ms. Fatima Jamil from ACELP and Dr. Salma Khalil also discussed in detail the possibility of future collaboration.







Session at Step Ahead School

A training session on Autism and Interoception was conducted by ASDWT at Step Ahead, an inclusive school in Lahore. This session was attended by parents and teachers. Dr. Husna Albab gave a detailed presentation on interoception, its role in the sensory system and its relationship with autism. She discussed interoception profiling techniques and assessment criteria, and how to improve interoception awareness in children and adults with autism. Ms. Rukhsana Shah shared her own hands-on experience with daily life examples. Ms. Sadia Atif, Director of Step Ahead was very happy with the ASDWT team for introducing a new aspect to autism management.

Government Vocational Training Institute (TEVTA), Dev Samaj Road, Lahore

A seminar on awareness of neurodevelopmental disorders was conducted GVTI, the Teachers Training Institute of TEVTA. Ms. Ayesha Arooj made a presented on Autism while Ms. Farah Amanat conducted a session on ADHD and Specific Learning Disabilities (SLD). The session was attended by Trainers of the Institute and its Principal. It was followed by a Q&A session and discussion about the necessity of including people with disabilities in the workforce.
