#### Workshops and Webinars




#### Workshop at The Learning Hub

ASDWT Lahore hosted a training session on Autism and Interoception at The Learning Hub on 3rd October 2023. The session was attended by parents and professionals. Dr. Husna Albab made an in-depth presentation on Interoception, its importance in the sensory system, and its relationship with gut problems in autism. The presentation concluded with a Q&A session.

#### Mental Health Awareness Day. Facebook Live Session

To mark World Mental Health Awareness Day, ASDWT organized a Facebook session on 10th October 2023. Renowned psychiatrist Prof. Dr. Saad Bashir Malik, Chairman Punjab Institute of Mental Health, and Founder & President of Mind organization spoke on this year's UN theme "Mental Health is a Universal Human Right." Dr. Saad explained that mental health remains one of the most neglected areas of public policy although the incidence of mental illness is increasing at an alarming rate in the country. The mass exodus of qualified psychiatrists from Pakistan should be a matter of urgent action by the government. The session was followed by a lively and interactive Q&A segment.





## Institute of Holistic Rehabilitation & Inclusion (IHRI) Visit and Awareness session at Herbion Naturals.

ASDWT Karachi organized an awareness session at Herbion Naturals on "Autism Spectrum Disorder and Specific Learning Disorders" on 12th October, 2023. Employees from different departments of Herbion attended the awareness session. The session generated a great deal of discussion and a Q&A segment with the participants.
